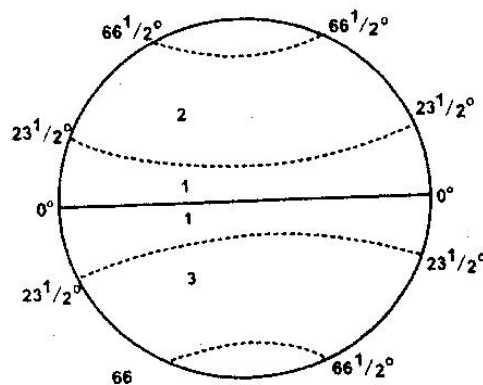

In this case water stays in the roots and the plants become rot. Sometimes, in salinity, a great amount of salt accumulates in the root region of the plants. This dissolves in water and roots cannot get food and the plants wither away. A literate farmer can face such challenges in a better way in comparison to an illiterate one.
